According to notes on Andrew Kuntz's Fiddler's Companion website, the tune was originally composed by James Oswald (c. 1711–1769) and was published in his Caledonian Pocket Companion (Bk. 4, 1752) under the title "She Gripped at the Greatest O't". It first appeared under the title of "East Neuk of Fife" in William McGibbon's (c. 1690–1756) Third Collection published in 1755.
